

The Boulder Rifle Club Junior Smallbore League is a program for kids aged 8 – 18. The club provides .22 rifles sized to the shooters, ammo, and targets. At the start of each season we conduct a 1-hour safety class. On an ongoing basis, we reinforce those safety practices as we instruct them in marksmanship. There are usually three coaches on the firing line with the kids. The only competition is for each shooter to score better than the week before, though many of our young shooters go on to other forms of competitive shooting as they mature.

The BRC Junior Smallbore League meets every Tuesday during 2 annual sessions, Fall and Summer. Fall runs from October through April, Summer from June through August. There are 2 relays, one at 6 PM and one at 7 PM, with 10 shooters on each. In years when demand is high, we have had to use a waiting list, so enquire early.
