- 1) Participants will bring their cased rifles into the range, remove the rifles keeping the muzzle pointed at the backstop, and put the cases in a safe place, either shelved behind the line, or back in the classroom area. When done, shooters will re-case their rifles at the firing line and remove them to the classroom area.
- 2) Participants will keep the muzzle pointed at the backstop while in all positions. Participants may make use of movable shelf-supports at the firing points to keep the muzzle safely directed while firing standing position or resting between shots. Participants will not mount the rifle by pointing at the ceiling and lowering the sights to the target.
- 3) Participants will not shoot the 2 X 4 supports or the metal posts behind the target surface. To avoid doing so, targets will be stapled up away from the supports.
- 4) Participants will immediately report any accidental discharge that strikes the supports, ceiling, floor or any area other than the target mounting surface, to the range officer on scene. The participant responsible for the accidental discharge may be required to help repair it.
- 5) Participants will observe the standard NRA rules:
 - a. Always keep the rifle pointed in a safe direction
 - b. Always keep your finger out of the trigger guard until the sights are aligned on the target.
 - c. Always keep the rifle unloaded until ready to shoot
